LAA REGULATIONS & NBA WARRANTIES: The Sale will be held subject to the LAA (Livestock Auctioneers Association) Rules, Regulations & Bye Laws of the respective Societies and all animals subject to the Fertility Guarantees as recommended by the NBA. Full copies of NBA Regulations can be obtained from the Auctioneer.

METHOD OF SALE: All pedigree cattle will be sold in Guineas (105 Pence) and strictly in catalogue order, unless any alterations are announced by the auctioneers. Commercial Cattle will be sold in £'s/head.

ONLINE BIDDING: Online bidding is available via Marteye. To sign up to Marteye follow the steps below:

1. Head to <https://meltonmowbraymarket.marteye.ie/>
2. Click sign in to create a Marteye account.

If you are a new customer please ensure you have created an account with the office prior to creating a Marteye account, you will then be issued with a Melton Market account number.

For new and existing customers please put your herd number as your Melton account number.

To create a Marteye account, you will either need a gmail account, or sign up with your mobile number. If you have an existing account, you will not be able to amend your details to add your Melton account number.

3. Once your account has been created click join to request to bid at Melton Market.
4. Once your request has been approved you will be set up to bid online.

Please ensure that you have registered to bid before 4pm on Friday the 26th March to ensure that your request to bid is approved before sale day.

ENTRY FORM AND FEE: Please ensure that you note the breed you wish to enter on the entry form and whether Pedigree, Production or Commercial. Entry fee of £25+VAT for all pedigree cattle. Cheques to be made payable to Melton Mowbray Market. Entry Fees are non-refundable unless accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate. Commercial cattle will not be charged an entry fee.

Details of stock and information provided are the Sole responsibility of the Vendor and not the respective Societies.

COMMISSION AND SOCIETY LEVIES: The commission on pedigree sales will be the guinea to the auctioneers and on commercial cattle will be 3.35% to the auctioneers. Respective Society Levies will be collected on their behalf at the normal rate. Purchaser Transfer Fees will be collected on behalf of Societies where requested.

STRAW: Straw will be provided and is included in the entry fee. Additional straw is available at an additional cost.

VETERINARY INSPECTION: For the buyer's convenience, a veterinary inspection will be carried out on all pedigree stock for sale. All pedigree stock must be haltered for inspection and will be paraded. The vet will examine the general health and genetic defects particularly teeth, eyes, testicals, warts and movement. Any animal found with a genetic fault, disease or disorder will be rejected. Weights and scrotal sizes should be within the Society Guidelines.

Commercial and unaltered production females will be inspected in their pens by a Society Inspector.

All cattle entered for the sale will have their UK Tags examined as an integral part of the pre-sale inspection procedure.

JUDGING: All Bulls and Haltered Females may be judged in their pens or in the Sale Ring. If judged in pens they may be paraded for the benefit of purchasers, prior to the Sale.

CLASSES: The classification will be decided and sub-divided into appropriate age categories after the entries have closed.

SALE TIMINGS:

Arrival of stock 2pm onwards

Inspection/Vetting 4pm – 6pm

Arrival of stock 6-8am

Inspection of stock 7am – 8.30am

ORDER OF SALE: The order of sale will be Lincoln Reds, Simmental, Salers, Aberdeen Angus, Beef Shorthorn, South Devons followed by any other breeds and high health commercial cattle.

PRE-SALE IMAGARY: The respective Societies and Melton Mowbray Market will publish photos and videos of lots on their website and social media platforms.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Any cattle deemed not to standard will be rejected and must be removed from the premises prior to the sale and not offered for sale.
- Any animal showing signs of bad temperament will be rejected (Society's/ markets decision is final).
- All vendors must comply with all legal movement requirements.
- All cattle must comply with pre-movement TB testing regulations. All entrants must disclose TB testing time.
- The official registration certificate issued by the society must accompany the entry form and entry fee along with the respective herd health declaration.
- An A.I. certificate must accompany the entry forms for any cows or heifers being sold described as in-calf by A.I.
- Entries for recipients with pedigree calves at foot are also invited.
- A cow and calf may be allocated: One lot number therefore sold together as one consignment (single entry fee), or Individual lot numbers therefore sold separately, providing the calf was born before 1st January 2020 (double entry fee).
- It must be stated, if any cows entered, have been flushed and how many embryos have been taken.
- In the case of bulls, it must be stated if any semen has been retained and if so how many straws.

NOTIFICATION OF MOVEMENTS TO BCMS: The auctioneers will notify BCMS electronically of all movements off farm through the market and onto the next holding.

TB TESTING: All cattle over 42 days of age, from 1 and 2 year testing areas, will need to have been TB tested within the last 60 days prior to the sale date. Pre-movement TB testing is compulsory in 1 and 2 year testing areas.

It is the responsibility of the vendor to check with the auctioneers prior to the sale, what is required. No cattle can be accepted for the sale unless official documentation regarding TB accompanies the entry form.



HEALTH: All animals forward must be in a CHECS approved Health Scheme; Accredited Free of BVD (Vaccinations optional according to respective Societies Regulations) and Herd Status must be within Risk Level 1 to 4 Johnes Status. If IBR and/or Lepto are not included as part of the Herd Health Scheme then animals forward must test negative for both diseases prior to Sale (vaccinations optional according to respective Societies Regulations).

COMMERCIAL STOCK: This is a High Health Sale so **all** Commercial Stock must be from CHECs Health Herds Accredited Free of BVD and in Johnes Risk Level 1 to 4 only. They must also test negative for IBR and Lepto prior to the Sale.

ALL DATES OF VACCINATIONS MUST BE GIVEN TO MELTON MARKET OFFICE

ALL CATTLE SHOULD BE OWNED BY THE VENDOR BUT DO NOT HAVE TO BE VENDOR BRED

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ANY OF THE ABOVE WILL RESULT IN ANIMALS BEING REJECTED FROM THE SALE

Melton Mowbray COVID-19 Regulations

These regulations will be updated in line with Government guidelines.

****COVID 19 UPDATE****

Due to National Lockdown we will be operating by the below regulations:

- Potential purchasers **MUST** register with the office no later than 48 hours prior to the sale, to do this please call 01664 562 971.
- Anyone attending the market on sale day must, **SIGN IN AND COLLECT A WRIST BAND FROM THE AUCTIONEERS OFFICE UPON ARRIVAL.**
- **PLEASE DO NOT TREAT THE MARKET AS A SOCIAL DAY OUT!**
- Children and those in the High-risk categories are **NOT PERMITTED** around the ring and down the alleys.
- Social distancing must be adhered to at all times, anybody not following these guidelines will be asked to leave the market.
- Please be reminded that face masks **MUST** be worn in **ALL** areas around the Market – Wearing a mask is **NOT** a substitute for social distancing.
- If you show any symptoms of the virus – **DO NOT ATTEND!**
 - Please note **THE GENERAL PUBLIC WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND THE LIVESTOCK AREAS** of the market.
