All Sales will be held under the present government guidelines, there will be restrictions applied to both vendors and purchasers attending the markets during these sales.

With the guideline information changing on a regularly, the details of the restrictions to attend the sales will be announced nearer to the scheduled dates.

CLASSES AVAILABLE:

BULLS - any age

All bulls must be halter led and rung.

FEMALES – open for any age of female

Halter led females will be sold prior to Unhalted Females.

All animals **MUST** be entered and registered in the herd book of the Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society and is open to all Members of the Society.

AN ENTRY FEE OF £30.00 (£25 + £5.00 VAT)

MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRY FORMS.

FAILURE TO DO SO MAY LEAD TO NON ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRY.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO VENDORS

HEALTH STATUS – All cattle entered must be from herds which are BVD accredited in which case the animals entered will require to be BVD vaccinated within 12 months prior to the date of sale. If the herd is not BVD accredited then the animals entered will require to be tested for BVD antigen and vaccinated against BVD within 3 months prior to the sale. All cattle entered must come from herds which are annually testing for Johne's in a CHeCS Approved Health scheme or from Johne's accredited herds.

DNA - The Society has arranged for DNA samples of all bulls entered to be taken prior to the sale. If your bull has not been sire verified or myostatin status confirmed prior to the official catalogue going to print, the bull will be removed from the catalogue and not be passed for sale.

CONDITIONS OF SALE – The Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society have adopted the Auction Rules and Conditions of Sale drawn up by the N.B.A. This Sale is held subject to these rules and the Auctioneers' General Conditions of Sale, both available on request. In the event of any discrepancy between the two sets of conditions, the N.B.A. Conditions of Sale shall prevail.

TB PRE-MOVEMENT TESTING - TB pre-movement testing is a mandatory requirement for all cattle over the age of 41 days moving out of 1-year tested herds must be pre-movement tested within 60 days prior to sale.

IDENTIFICATION MARKS - All cattle entered for the sale will have their UK identification marks examined as an integral part of the pre-sale inspection procedure. Any marks found to have faulty, incorrect or illegible marks will be REJECTED from the Sale, Vendors are therefore urged, in their own interests, to examine the UK tags marks of Sale Cattle before the animals leave their farm, so that faulty marks can be rectified in accordance with the required Society procedures.

PRE-SALE INSPECTION - All animals entered for sale must be available for inspection in the sale premises at the time specified in the sale catalogue.

“All animals (except in the case of bona-fide dispersals) are subject to pre-sale inspections by the Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society in order to establish identity and to provide a minimum standard. Such Inspections however do not imply any liability or warranty by the Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society for animals sold, such liability remains the responsibility of the vendor. Animals are sold with all patent defects and any subsequent claim is against the vendor and not the Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society.”

Any dispersal consignments will be subject to the pre-sale inspections. Inability to properly inspect such unled females will automatically debar them from the sale.

A VETERINARY CERTIFICATE MUST BE SUPPLIED FOR ANY ANIMAL NOT FORWARD FOR SALE.

UPSET PRICE - There will be an 'Upset Price' of 1800gns on each bull entered for the sale, if no opening bid of 1800gns is received for any particular lot, the animal concerned will pass out the sale ring unsold.

The proceeds of sale are guaranteed by the Auctioneers, who will account to Vendors on the day of sale. Such guarantee, however, does not extend to animals for export, to which special conditions apply.

ACCEPTANCE OF STOCK: Due to present DEFRA regulations the arrival stock can only be accepted onto the market premises the day prior to the sale. Any alteration will be notified to all vendors however we request that all arrival times must be strictly adhered to when published in the sale catalogue.
